
*Thursday* 11/7/19




*Monday* 15/7/19



The Juniors went to Moving Bodies and did parkour but a safer version. They played lots of games until it was time to go.

The juniors watched a Maya and the sea dragon play. They joined a wonderful adventure under the sea with Maya and uncovered the wonders of the sea dragon Koru.




*Friday* 19/7/19


Seniors- Ice skating at Bondi
